


## Paperwork Reduction Act and Privacy Act Statement

The following information is provided to comply with the Privacy Act of 1974

(P.L. 93-579). The information requested on the form is required under various provisions of title 15 U.S.C. 1601, 12 CFR 205, and 31 CFR 202, for the purpose of providing authority to the Department of Treasury to designate financial institutions to collect payments, by electronic means, from your account. The information will be used for identification with the records of the government agency and the financial institution to direct your payments to the point you authorize. No deduction may be made unless a signed authorization form is received. Failure to furnish this information may delay or prevent the collection of these payments through the Automated Clearing House System.



# Pre-Existing Condition Insurance Plan Preauthorized Debits

A preauthorized debit is an electronic transfer of funds, through the Automated Clearing House system, from an



individual's or company's bank account to the Federal Government. The

National Finance Center, Pre-Existing Condition Insurance Plan debits from your account only after you, the remitter, have authorized it to do so.

Preauthorized debits let the National Finance Center collect payments automatically on a predetermined date.

Checks are a thing of the past when you make the move to preauthorized debits. With the safety and security of electronic transfer of funds, you have the guarantee that your payment will be made, not lost in the mail.
